I am requesting \$1,550,000 for the City of Casey Fairview Park Resurfacing project in Casey, Illinois in fiscal year 2027.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Casey, located at 101 W Alabama Ave, Casey, IL 62420-1132.

The proposed project will resurface the deteriorated roadways within the City of Casey's Fairview Park. The existing pavement has experienced significant wear due to age, weather, and traffic, resulting in cracking, potholes, and unsafe driving conditions. These deficiencies create safety concerns for park visitors and increase ongoing maintenance costs.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars and is anticipated to have the following benefits. The park serves as a central community and economic asset for the City of Casey, supporting youth sports, community events, and tourism-related activity. Upgrading the roadway infrastructure will preserve public investment, improve the visitor experience, and strengthen the City's ability to host events that generate local economic impact.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
