8 (1) establish qualifications for each human re9 sources position within the Veterans Health Admin10 istration of the Department of Veterans Affairs;

(2) establish standardized performance metricsfor each such position; and

(3) submit to Congress a report containing the
qualifications and standardized performance metrics
established under paragraphs (1) and (2).

(b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the establishment of the qualifications and performance metrics
under subsection (a), the Comptroller General of the
United States shall submit to the Committee on Veterans'
Affairs of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate a report containing—

(1) a description of the implementation of such

25 (2) an assessment of the quality of such quali-26 fications and performance metrics.
