**A BILL**

To require the Corps of Engineers to consider benefits to  
navigation to be gained by certain projects, and for other  
purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Levee Rehabilitation  
5       Improvements Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. CONSIDERATION OF BENEFITS.**

7       Section 5(a)(2)(A) of the Flood Control Act of 1941  
8       (33 U.S.C. 701n(a)(2)(A)) is amended to read as follows:

1           “(A) CONSIDERATION OF BENEFITS.—In  
2           preparing a cost and benefit feasibility assess-  
3           ment for any emergency project described in  
4           paragraph (1), the Chief of Engineers shall con-  
5           sider—

6                   “(i) the benefits to be gained by such  
7                   project for the protection of—

8                           “(I) residential establishments;

9                           “(II) commercial establishments,  
10                   including the protection of inventory;  
11                   and

12                           “(III) agricultural establish-  
13                   ments, including the protection of  
14                   crops; and

15                   “(ii) the benefits to navigation to be  
16                   gained by such project.”.
